

1 Making endnotes clickable

The new syntax for the `\endnote` command is,

```
\endnote*[<num>]{<note-text>}\label{<name>}
```

The use of * causes the endnote mark not to appear. If `\label{<name>}` appears, a hypertext link is created pointing to the placement of the endnote at the end of the document.

- Some beginning text.¹
- Refer to endnote.²
- Another method is to use the *-form and use `\autoref` to display the reference to endnote 3.
- Now make another endnote.⁴
- This is an endnote with two paragraphs in endnote 5.
- Here, we try `\Nameref`, `\nameref`, `\autoref`: ‘Notes’ on page 2, Notes, endnote 2.
 - This is a specially number endnote.^{N1}
 - We reference endnote⁶ on page 2.
