

Example for footnoterange

This example demonstrates the use of package
footnoterange, v1.1b as of 2025-01-27, references to ranges of footnotes (HMM).
The package does not use options.

This¹ text bears a multiplicity of footnotes. Because the `hyperref` package is used with option `hyperfootnotes=true`, the footnotes^{2–9} are hyperlinked.¹⁰ Using `hyperfootnotes=false` or not using `hyperref` will remove the hyperlinks to the footnotes.

This text also bears a multiplicity of footnotes, but due to the use of the starred^{11–18} form of the environment they are not hyperlinked.¹⁹

The use of the optional parameter for footnotes^{101–105} is also possible, but should be used consistently.

When there is only one footnote²⁵ in the `footnoterange` environment, only one footnotemark is used and an info is written into the `log`-file.

The usage of other footnote-number-representations (e.g. `\RomanXXVI-XXX`, `\romanxxxix-xxxx`, `\AlphAJ-AN`, `\alphao-as`, `\fnsymbol*****-|||||`) is also possible, but two things must be taken into account:

1. By default the number of footnote references is restricted (for example with `\Alph` only references A to Z are possible), which needs to be fixed. In this example the `alphalph` package is used for this purpose.
2. References to footnote-symbol-ranges (`\fnsymbol`) might not be very clear. For example, if the symbols `*†‡§¶**††` are used, `†-††` means second to seventh footnote.
But if `*†‡§¶**††` are used, `†-††` means second to eighth footnote.
And if `*†‡**††‡‡` are used, `†-††` means second to fifth footnote.
